

## **Behaviour Policy**

### **Covid-19 Appendix**

If a child's behaviour is deemed high risk, for example, refusing to adhere to safety measures, such as, hand washing, social distancing, remaining in their bubbles or deliberate behaviours that put themselves or others at risk, such as spitting or deliberately coughing at people. The following procedures should be used:

- Send a "red hand" (laminated hand with class name on) to the member of SLT who is on duty support with the situation.
- SLT to request that a phone call is made to the school office where a member of the office staff on will contact parents for immediate collection.
- SLT to remain with the child until the parent collects and report the behavior to the parent.
- Depending on the severity of the behavior, parents will be informed as to when the child can next attend.

This list is not limited and includes any behaviours that make the adult leading the bubble feel unsafe or behaviours that take their attention away from the rest of the group thus making an unsafe environment for them.
