

## Autumn Term 1 Year 1 Music

### Key facts

This half term children will:

- Sing songs to focus listening and recognise a variety of sound
- Create a variety of sounds using hands
- Create a piece of music
- Sing songs adding vocal sounds and body percussion
- Identify sound sources
- Play a variety of sounds using percussion instruments
- Develop skill of handling instruments
- Conduct starting and stopping
- Explore playing city sounds

Children will appreciate that music is created through a process and perform in front of an audience.

### Exploring Sound Jazz

### Brief summary/ overview

This half term children will explore sound through the genre of jazz and its use of improvisation.

They will use body percussion and develop their control of percussion instruments. They will learn to create a variety of sounds and create their own piece of music before performing to an audience.

Children will have built a repertoire of songs and explored the use of musical instruments in reception.
